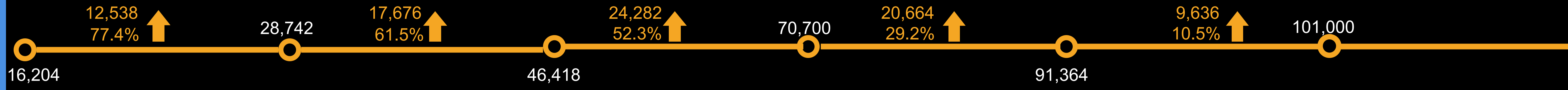
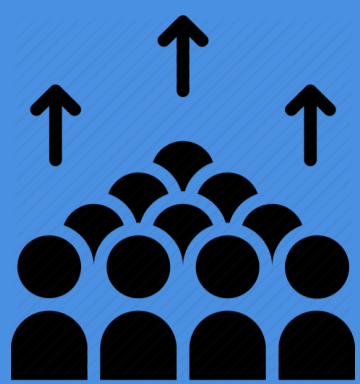

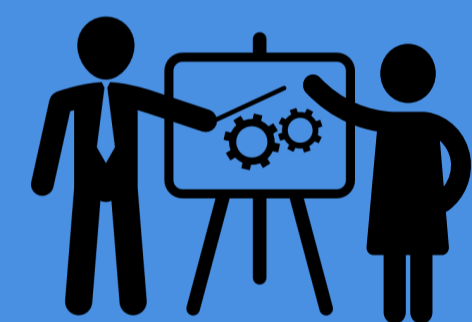

### Lee's Summit: 21st Century

- 3/8 cent sales tax for park improvements
- 1/2 cent sales tax for transportation
- GO bonds for:
  - police/court facility
  - fire station #6
- water tap fee sewer connection fee
- 1/2 cent sales tax for capital improvements
- hotel/motel tax
- transportation excise tax
- adoption of charter

### Lee's Summit 360

- increase compensation program
- increase police districts from 7 to 10
- added 2 ambulances, 9 staff at fire station #6
- GO bonds for public safety:
  - emergency services radio
  - police facility improvements
  - indoor firearm training
  - emergency services radio equipment & connectivity
  - fire station #3
  - equipment & apparatus
- GO bonds for:
  - public infrastructure (curbs, sidewalks)
  - 291/50 hwy improvements
- parks 1/4 cent & capital improvements 1/2 cent sales taxes (cont. 15 yrs)
- downtown cultural arts center & Legacy Park amphitheater
- economic development policy
