

BILL NO. 17-266

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTING GEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$76,000.00 AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT POLICY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a Procurement Policy which permits the purchase of items through a cooperative agreement; and,

WHEREAS, such Procurement Policy requires the approval of the City Council if the annual spend exceeds \$50,000.00 in any given year; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Department is desirous of purchasing Structural Firefighting Gear under and through the LION-NPPGov Contract PS16008, which qualifies as a cooperative purchasing agreement under the City's Procurement Policy ; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the anticipated annual spend exceeds \$50,000.00 for the annual spend period requiring City Council approval of the cooperative purchasing agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, being duly apprised in the matter, hereby approves LION-NPPGov publicly solicited procurement contract No. PS16008, a cooperative purchasing agreement as provided for in the City's approved Procurement Policy, for use by the City and the purchase of Structural Firefighting Gear in an amount not to exceed \$76,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any documents and take such actions as are necessary to carry out such purchase by and on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
