

BILL NO. 16-180

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE AUGUST 2, 2016, PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, a primary election was held in the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, on August 2, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the official return of the election has been received from the Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners, certified by such board; and,

WHEREAS, the official return of the election has been received from the Election Authority of Cass County, certified by such authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the official return of the election, as submitted by the Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners is as follows:

QUESTION 1

Shall the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, discontinue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer?
