AN ORDINANCE AWARDING BID NO. 57831683-C, FOR THE CATHODIC PROTECTION PROGRAM FY20 TO KANTEX INDUSTRIES, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$278,836.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, ductile iron water mains were installed in the Winterset Park and Longview Farm areas during the 1990's and 1980's; and,

WHEREAS, due to corrosion of iron pipe, over forty water main breaks have occurred in the Winterset Park and Longview Farm areas since 2006; and,

WHEREAS, to reduce the rate of corrosion and extend the service life of the water mains in selected areas of Winterset Park and Longview Farm, 395 high potential magnesium anodes will be installed with this project as part of a cathodic protection program; and,

WHEREAS, Public Works Engineering issued Bid No. 57831683-C on December 13, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, Kantex Industries, Inc., was determined to be the lowest and most responsible bidder by City Staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby authorizes the award of bid no. 57831683-C to KANTEX INDUSTRIES, INC., in the amount of \$278,836.00.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit hereby authorizes the execution, by the City Manager, of an agreement with Kantex Industries, Inc., for the services contained in bid no. 57831683-C in an amount of \$278,836.00. Said contract is on file with the City of Lee's Summit Water Utilities Department and is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein..

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
