A perfectly harmonised range of equipment components is available for the BMW R 1200 RT-P developed specifically to ensure the comfort, functionality and safety for the rider.



The LED flashlight and rotating beacon with telescopic rod can be controlled separately at the front and rear. The LED display can be programmed to show "Stop" or "Please follow".



Newly developed additional switch units include freely programmable keys for special functions. The logically arranged controls ensure simply handling.



Everything in view: the clearly structured and ergonomically arranged instruments in the cockpit allow the rider to relax and concentrate on the traffic.



Analog and digital radio end devices can be used at the same time and are securely stowed in the electrically unlockable radio box.



Impressive signalling effect in various situations: all LED flashlights and the beacon can be ordered in blue, red or yellow as required.



The newly developed weather protection package ensures resistance to dirt, rain and spray water even in the most adverse weather conditions.
