

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on March 22, 1972, President Richard Nixon signed into law a measure amending the Older Americans Act of 1965 to include a national nutrition program for seniors 60 years and older; and

WHEREAS, for more than five decades, this landmark law has helped to fund community-based organizations, like Meals on Wheels, and is still the only federal program designed specifically to meet the nutritional and social needs of older adults; and

WHEREAS, this year, Meals on Wheels programs from across the country are joining together for the March for Meals awareness campaign to celebrate its success and garner the support needed to ensure these critical programs can continue to address food insecurity and malnutrition, combat social isolation, enable independence and improve health for years to come; and

WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels programs – both congregate and home delivered in Lee’s Summit, Missouri, have served our community admirably for more than 49 years, and

WHEREAS, volunteers for Meals on Wheels are the backbone of the program and they not only deliver nutritious meals to seniors and individuals with disabilities who are at significant risk of hunger and isolation, but also caring concern and attention to their welfare; and

WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels programs in Lee’s Summit deserves recognition for the heroic contributions and essential services they have provided amid the COVID-19 pandemic, inclement weather and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the senior population is increasing substantially, and action is needed now to support local Meals on Wheels programs through federal, state and local funding; volunteering; donations; and raising awareness to ensure these vital services can continue to be delivered for years to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, William A. Baird, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Lee’s Summit, Missouri, do hereby proclaim the month of March 2023 as

MARCH FOR MEALS MONTH

and urge our community to honor our senior nutrition programs, the individuals they serve and the volunteers who care for them. By supporting these programs, we can enrich our entire community and help combat senior hunger and isolation in America.
