## **BILL NO. 25-166**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE CERTAIN DISPATCH SERVICES TO THE CITY OF SUGAR CREEK BY THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri (hereinafter "City") is a municipal corporation operating and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, the City has established and operates the Lee's Summit Fire Department Communications Center (hereafter "the Communications Center") with equipment and personnel for dispatching fire, emergency medical, and other related emergencies; and,

WHEREAS, the City has the capability and desire to make the dispatching services of the Fire Department Communications Center available to other governmental entities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sugar Creek (hereafter "Contracting Agency") desires to contract for such dispatching services; and,

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 16 of the Missouri Constitution and Section 70.220 RSMo., permit an Agreement for a common service between political subdivisions as long as the service is within the powers of the political subdivisions, and Section 321.220 RSMo., provides that fire protection districts may contract with municipalities; and,

WHEREAS such legislation contemplates joint agreements between units of government to provide governmental services; and,

WHEREAS, contracting with a communications center that provides service to multiple entities is the most economical and desirable way to provide for dispatching services within the corporate limits of the Contracting Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contracting Agency which to enter into the attached intergovernmental agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1 That the Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of dispatch services, a true and accurate copy being attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth, be and is hereby approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the agreements on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
