AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF RFQ NO. 2026-014 AND AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CEDAR CREEK INTERCEPTOR PHASE 4 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO BURNS & MCDONNELL ENGINEERING COMPANY, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$305,753.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Interceptor Phase 4 Improvements (“Project”) is identified in the 2022 Wastewater Master Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council programmed funding for the Project as part of the FY 2026 Capital Improvements Plan (CIP); and,

WHEREAS, City Staff issued RFQ No. 2026-014 to conduct a qualification-based selection for professional engineering services in accordance with state statutes and local procurement policies; and,

WHEREAS, after review of those submissions for RFQ No. 2026-014, Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc (“Engineer”) was determined to be the most qualified firm to undertake such assignment; and,

WHEREAS, following successful scope and fee negotiations, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Engineer for the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee’s Summit, Missouri, hereby approves the award of RFQ No. 2026-014 to the Engineer in the amount of \$305,753.00.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Lee’s Summit, Missouri, hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute an Agreement for Professional Engineering Services, substantially similar to the attached Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference, with the Engineer for the Project on behalf of the City of Lee’s Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
