AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF RFQ NO. 2025-070 FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR SCHERER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION -- WARD ROAD TO M291 BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AND LOCHMUELLER GROUP, INC, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,249,297.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Scherer Road Reconstruction - Ward Road To M291 ("Project") was authorized in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) adopted by Council; and,

WHEREAS, the Project will be funded from the voter-approved 2017 CIP Sales Tax Renewal and NTIB 2023 Transportation funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City staff issued RFQ No. 2025-070 to conduct a Qualification Based Selection for professional engineering services in accordance with state statutes, federal regulations, and local procurement policies; and,

WHEREAS, Lochmueller Group, Inc ("Engineer") was selected as the most qualified firm for the Project and satisfactorily conducted negotiations for scope and fee with City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Engineer desire to enter into an agreement to complete the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the award of RFQ No. 2025-070 to the Engineer for an amount not to exceed \$1,249,297.00.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the City Manager, by and on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, to execute an agreement for Professional Engineering Services, substantially similar to the attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, with the Engineer for the Project.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
