THE ENGAGEMENT PLAN

- 1. Review Best Management Practices
 - City staff to research, survey and meet with peer cities
- 2. HOA Meetings
 - Each Council District to host 6-8 HOA's (i.e. HOA Officers) from active HOA's (Contracting and Not Contracting)
- 3. Industry Representative Meetings
 - City staff will meet, survey and receive service provider feedback
- 4. Public Engagement Sessions
 - Four resident town hall meetings (one for each District) to receive citizen input


THE ENGAGEMENT PLAN (CONTINUED)

- 5. Develop Task Force for RFP Development & Recommendations
 - Form Solid Waste Task Force from Engaged Groups (HOA's, Industry, Citizens)
 - Create Request for Proposals (RFP) to Contract Residential Solid Waste Services
- 6. Public Works Committee RFP Work Sessions, RFP Review and Recommendations to City Council
- 7. City Council Consideration of Recommended RFP
 - Public Comment Opportunity
