RESOLUTION 18-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI TO PARTICIPATE IN COOPERATIVE-PIGGYBACK PURCHASING PROGRAMS – CONTRACTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri ("City") adopted a Purchasing Policy by Resolution No. 16-20 on October 5, 2017; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-04, on February 18, 1999, the City Council adopted the City's first Purchasing Policy, which set forth guidelines for obtaining necessary goods and services at the most economical prices while ensuring compliance with all applicable laws and policies and maintaining confidence in government expenditures; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Procurement Policy was adopted by City Council by passage of Bill No. 17-212 on October 5, 2017 which became Ordinance No. 8253; and,

WHEREAS, the practice of the City Council is to approve the participation of the City in piggyback or cooperative procurement agreements by resolution from time to time, which the Council believe appropriate creating an "Approved List"; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to update the "Approved List" for use of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Lee's Summit is currently participating in or piggybacking off of the following cooperative procurement programs/contracts: Kansas City, Missouri, City of Lenexa, Kansas, City of Joplin, Missouri, City of Independence, Missouri, City of Belton, Missouri, City of Olathe, Kansas, City of Springfield, Missouri, City of St. Petersburg, Florida, Jackson County, Missouri, Clay County, Missouri, Johnson County, Kansas, Fairfax County, Virginia, State of Missouri, State of Kansas, MARC-KCRPC: Mid-America Regional Council-Kansas City Regional Purchasing Council, Jackson County Missouri Circuit Court, Kansas City, Missouri Police Department, Kansas City, Missouri School District, Jasper County Sheriff Office, SEKESC-Southeast Kansas Education Service Center, MODOT-Missouri Department of Transportation, HGAC-Houston-Galveston Area Council, GSA-General Services Administration, U.S. Communities, NPP-National Purchasing Partners-Government, NASPO ValuePoint-The National Association of State Procurement Officials, NIPA/TCPN- National IPA (National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance/TCPN (The Cooperative Purchasing Network), NJPA-National Joint Powers Alliance, NCPA-National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance and BuyBoard.

SECTION 2. That the City of Lee's Summit shall be authorized to participate in, sponsor, conduct, award, or administer cooperative-piggyback purchasing programs-contracts with the United States or any agency of the United States; with the State of Missouri or any agency, municipality or political subdivision of the State of Missouri; with other states or any

agency, municipality or political subdivision of any other state; or with any association of
municipalities, political subdivisions or national purchasing consortiums; provided that such
contract was established in accordance with the laws and regulations applicable to the
establishing entity and to the policies adopted by the City of Lee's Summit.
