AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF RFP NO. 2025-029 FOR THE PROVISION OF HEALTH INSURANCE AND EMPLOYEE BENEFIT BROKERAGE/CONSULTING SERVICES TO ALLIANT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC., LLC FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM WITH UP TO FOUR, ONE-YEAR RENEWALS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri (the "City") has utilized health insurance and employee benefit brokerage/consulting services since 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the City's current agreement has expired and the City issued Request for Proposal No. 2025-029 ("RFP") to conduct for the selection of health insurance and employee benefit brokerage/consulting services to begin March 1, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the RFP was posted on the City's website, as well as the City's e-procurement system, Public Purchase, which notified 103 possible vendors. The RFP was accessed by 28 vendors; and,

WHEREAS, as of the close of the time period for submission of the RFP, a total of eight (8) proposals were received by the City and four (4) proposals resulted in interviews; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the evaluation of proposals, as well as the comparative cost analysis conducted by the Procurement and Contract Services Division, the project evaluation committee recommended awarding this contract to Alliant Insurance Services, Inc.:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the award of a contract in response to RFP No. 2025-029 to Alliant Insurance Services, Inc. for the provision of health insurance and employee benefit brokerage/consulting services.

SECTION 2. The agreement between the City of Lee's Summit and Alliant Insurance Services, Inc. to provide health insurance and employee benefit brokerage/consulting services, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is approved, and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement in substantial compliance with the attached version. The City Council hereby delegates authority to City staff to negotiate such changes to the Agreement and its exhibits as are necessary to complete the Agreement and carry out the purposes and intent of the Project for the City, provided that the price paid for the services and the other items which constitute the consideration do not change.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
