Special Events	Food Cart Permitting	UDO, Article 6, Division V, Subdivision 2, Section 6.1610	No approvals for food carts located on public sidewalks or public parking spaces from 6-11-26 to 7-19-26.
Special Events	Fireworks (Large Public Displays)	UDO, Article 6, Division V, Section 6.1530	No approvals for large public fireworks displays from 6-11-26 to 7-19-26, except for "legacy" events (i.e., Legacy Blast, Lakewood display and Raintree Lake display). Special Events	Commercial Special Events	UDO, Article 6, Division V, Section 6.1530	No approvals for commercial events requiring additional security (1,000 people or more) from 6-11-26 to 7-19-26. Staff scrutiny of events with traffic impacts.
Special Events	Entertainment Special Events	UDO, Article 6, Division V, Section 6.1530	No approvals for entertainment events from June 1, 2026 - July 25, 2026
Special Events	Athletic Special Events (5K, Marathon, Triathlon, Bike Race, etc.)	UDO, Article 6, Division V, Section 6.1530	No approvals for athletic events from 6-1-26 to 7-25-26.

For second locations - instead of requiring full Business License, create an abbreviated one and still charge \$50 fee
Licensing	Short Term Rentals	UDO Article 6, Division II, Subdivision 2, Sec 6.505	Recommend removing restrictions on lot size, lot location, and residential building type that is allowed to have an STR. Also remove cap on 2 bedroom max that can be rented. Still require a Business License and \$50 fee but create an abbreviated/temporary License Application
Licensing	Liquor Licensing	Chapter 4	No changes recommended.
Licensing	Peddlers/Solicitors Permit	Chapter 20. Not sure where in ord., but aware of "rules" that exist for permitting at certain intersections/locations within ROW, limited occurrences per year, etc. (Solicitation in the Roadway)	No approvals during WC2026
Environmental	Littering/Illegal Dumping	Chapter 25 (Solid Waste)	No change
