## **Protective Treatment**



- Lee's Summit currently uses the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC)
  - Working to adopt the 2024 International Property Maintenance Code in 2025.
    - Protective Treatment code will not change with new code adoption.
- <u>304.2 Protective Treatment</u>

In summary, the code states that protective treatment refers to exterior surfaces being maintained in good condition and protected from the elements and decay by painting or other protective covering and treatments.

### **Protective Treatment**


- Majority of comparable cities have also adopted the 2018 IPMC and use officer discretion when determining if a violation exists.
- Only variance is Lenexa, KS.
  - Will enforce if 25% + of the surface area of one side of a structure or component (garage door, window, etc.) has a violation.

Our department recommendation is to maintain current process.



### **Commercial Property Maintenance**

- Comparative cities enforce the same codes for commercial as they do residential. Lee's Summit does as well.
- Landscape and trash is cited most often.
- We refer to the Final Development Plan when asking properties to replace/remove landscaping and trees. Comparative cities mentioned this method as well.
- Department recommendation is to maintain current process.
