

BILL NO. 26-107

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TWO-YEAR RENEWAL OF THE WORKERS COMPENSATION EXCESS POLICY, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIDWEST EMPLOYERS FOR THE DEPOSIT PREMIUM OF \$163,800, FOR FY2027 AND THE SAME IN FY2028, AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN COVERAGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri is a constitutional charter City, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri (hereinafter "City"); and,

WHEREAS, the City currently maintains a worker's compensation insurance program, wherein the City contract with Risk Strategies Thomas McGee Group for claims management services; and,

WHEREAS, the City's current worker's compensation manager Risk Strategies Thomas McGee Group conducted marketing efforts this spring on behalf of the City for its Excess Workers Compensation insurance; and,

WHEREAS, Midwest Employers Insurance has provided desirable proposals and quotes for renewal of the City's excess workers compensation insurance program and having evaluated the market and responses from all the carries who responded, Risk Strategies Thomas McGee Group recommends a two-year renewal with Midwest Employers Insurance; and,

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted funds to account for the premium costs, brokerage fees, and anticipated claims expenses and losses for FY2027 and anticipates doing so in FY2028, which specifically includes budgeted funds to cover various losses to be determined through the claims process; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the two-year proposal from Midwest Employers Insurance and enter into an agreement to procure Excess Worker's Compensation coverage for FY2027 and FY2028 subject to the adoption of the FY 2028 budget; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The two-year (FY2027 and FY2028) Worker's Compensation Excess Insurance program for the City of Lee's Summit as reflected in Exhibit "A" is hereby accepted and the City Manager is authorized to execute any and all agreements and other documents necessary to effectuate the procurement of coverage for excess worker's compensation insurance and related services with Midwest Employers Insurance on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from account no. CC1040-F630-PG057, in the budget the amount of \$163,800, for FY2027 for the purposes set forth on Section 1 above. The City Manager is further empowered to adjust this appropriation as may be needed to conform this ordinance to the budget when it is adopted.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is further empowered subject to the FY2028 budget when it

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is adopted, to expend the sum of \$168,300 for the Worker’s Compensation Excess Insurance program for the City of Lee’s Summit as reflected in Exhibit “A” and to adjust this appropriation as may be needed to conform this ordinance to the FY 2028 budget when it is adopted.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
