

## **BILL NO. 26-137**

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AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF RFQ 2026-065 FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE BIG CREEK EXCESS FLOW HOLDING AND PUMP STATION PROJECT TO GEORGE BUTLER ASSOCIATES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$294,393.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, as approved in the FY26 Capital Improvement Plan, the City has need of engineering services for the preliminary design of the Big Creek Excess Flow Holding and Pump Station Project ("Project"); and,

WHEREAS, this Project was identified in the 2021 Wastewater Master Plan and is intended to resolve projected capacity constraints of the Big Creek Interceptor; and,

WHEREAS, this Project is funded from the Sewer Tap Fund; and,

WHEREAS, City staff publicly advertised RFQ No. 2026-065 seeking qualified firms to provide professional engineering services for the Project, guided by local policies and state statutes; and,

WHEREAS, after review of those submissions for RFQ No. 2026-065, Gorge Butler Associates, Inc. ("Engineer") was determined to be the most qualified firm; and,

WHEREAS, following successful scope and fee negotiations, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Engineer to design the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the Agreement for RFQ 2026-065 to the Engineer in the amount of \$294,393.00.

SECTION 2. The agreement between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Engineer, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved, and the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement substantially similar to the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
