AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, THROUGH THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD, AND THE JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT OF METROPOLITAN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI OUTLINING THE MUTUAL SHELTERING AND REUNIFICATION AGREEMENT FOR THE METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit is a constitutional charter City, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri ("City"); and,

WHEREAS, the Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation Board ("Board") is empowered, pursuant to the Charter of the City of Lee's Summit, with the control of the supervision, improvement, care, and custody of parks and recreation activities in the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, the Board and The Junior College District Of Metropolitan Kansas City, Missouri ("MCC") desire to enter into an agreement for the purpose of allowing the mutual use of each other's adjacent facilities for sheltering and reunification purposes in the event of emergency or crisis situations, subject to general terms and conditions which have been mutually negotiated; and.

WHEREAS, Section 70.220, RSMo. and Section 4.4(d) of the Charter of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, requires that the Mayor execute all agreements and contracts between the City and other governmental entities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, through the Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation Board, and MCC, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the purpose of providing mutual sheltering and a reunification center is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same or substantially similar by and on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
