AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR PROJECT NO. 102 FOR THE 3<sup>RD</sup> ST & BRIDLEWOOD DR./PEALE BLVD. AND TODD GEORGE PKWY. & CHIPMAN RD. TRAFFIC SIGNALS TO CUSTOM LIGHTING SERVICES, LLC DBA BLACK AND MCDONALD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$792,170.10, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, Traffic conditions at NE Todd George Pkwy and NE Chipman Rd met traffic signal warrants in a study completed in July 2018; and,

WHEREAS, Traffic conditions at SW 3rd Street and SW Bridlewood Dr/Peale Blvd met traffic signal warrants in a study completed in June 2023; and,

WHEREAS, the SW 3rd St & SW Bridlewood Dr/Peale Blvd and Todd George Pkwy & Chipman Rd Traffic Signals Project (hereinafter "Project No. 102") will be funded from the Transportation Sales Tax; and,

WHEREAS, Project No. 102 was advertised for bid in February of 2025, in accordance with state and federal statutes and local policies; and,

WHEREAS, Custom Lighting Services, LLC dba Black and McDonald (hereinafter "Contractor") was determined to be the lowest and best responsive and responsible bidder by City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor desire to enter into an agreement for Project No. 102.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the bid for Project No. 102 to the Contractor in the amount of \$792,170.10.

SECTION 2. The agreement between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Contractor, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved, and the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement substantially similar to the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
