
Sec. 5-200. Number and type of chickens allowed.

- A. The maximum number of chickens allowed is six (6) per tract of land regardless of how many dwelling units are on the tract except that a maximum number of chickens allowed is eight (8) per tract on residential parcels greater than one half (1/2) acre.
- B. Only female chickens are allowed. There is no restriction on the chicken species, as defined in Section 5-2.
- C. Subparts A. and B. of this subsection shall not apply when the chicken(s) kept are four hundred (400) feet or more from the residence of any other inhabitant.
