AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI FOR THE ON CALL WORK ZONE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission has authorized funds to be used to support Statewide Transportation Improvement Program On Call Work Zone Enforcement activities within the City of Lee's Summit for a term of five years beginning July 1, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Police Department desires to provide additional safety to those individuals working, and motorists navigating through, work zones and has indicated its willingness and ability to provide such work zone enforcement; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Lee's Summit to approve the intergovernmental agreement to obtain such funding for the on call work zone enforcement program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission and the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri for the on call work zone enforcement program funding, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
