AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR PROJECT NO. 962 FOR THE MANHOLE REHABILITATION PROJECT, AS PART OF THE I/I REMOVAL – CIPP LINING, MANHOLE REHAB, AND LCR'S – FY24, TO KISSICK CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$757,000.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, to reduce inflow and infiltration in targeted areas of town, approximately 47 manholes will be replaced, 14 manhole frame and covers will be replaced, and 115 vertical linear feet of manhole will be lined; and,

WHEREAS, the Manhole Rehabilitation Project (hereinafter "Project No. 962") is funded by the Sewer Construction Fund and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Wastewater Legislative Priority grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, Water Utilities issued a bid for Project No. 962 on August 26, 2024, in accordance with local policies and state statutes, and opened bids on September 25, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, Kissick Construction Company, Inc. (hereinafter "Contractor") was determined to be the lowest and most responsible and responsive bidder by City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor desire to enter into an agreement for Project 962.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the bid for Project No. 962 to the Contractor in the amount of \$757,000.00.

SECTION 2. The agreement between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Contractor, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved, and the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement substantially similar to the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
