AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PUBLIC SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI AND THE LEE'S SUMMIT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FOR SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City, by Ordinance No. 4611, imposed a license tax on certain gross receipts of hotels, motels and similar places of business, the proceeds of which were to be used to promote the general economic welfare of the City, including, but not limited to, the attraction and retention of business and industry to the community and/or the promotion and provision of facilities for tourism, conventions, and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, the LSEDC was established, in part, to assist the City in expanding and diversifying the economic base of Lee's Summit through the attraction and retention of business and industry; and,

WHEREAS, the LSEDC has adopted new bylaws, reconstituted the Board of Directors, resumed programming, and is soliciting private and public investment into the LSEDC; and,

WHEREAS, the LSEDC makes a positive contribution to the City's economic environment through organizational leadership and structure, participation in development and redevelopment discussions, community asset advocacy, and development and implementation of economic strategies; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City, and important to the promotion of the general economic welfare of the City, to contract with LSEDC for the performance of various economic development services as outlined in this public service agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Public Service Agreement between the City and Lee's Summit Economic Development Council (LSEDC) for economic development services attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is approved, and the City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement in substantially the same form as the attached by and on behalf of the City and to effectuate all documents or actions to implement the agreement.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
