AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE CONTRACT BETWEEN JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI AND KENTON BROTHERS, INC, TO PURCHASE LOCKSMITH AND SECURITY SYSTEM SERVICES AND SUPPLIES AS NEEDED AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri (the "City") has a need to purchase locksmith and security system services and supplies as needed; and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the Procurement policy allows the City to make purchases from contracts that were originally procured by another entity but have extended the pricing and terms of such contract to other entities such as the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City is able to purchase locksmith and security system services and supplies pursuant to a contract between Jackson County and Kenton Brothers Inc. ("Cooperative Contract No. 2017-131"); and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the Procurement Policy requires that cooperative contracts that have an estimated annual spend of \$50,000 or more be approved by City Council before they are used; and,

WHEREAS, the City anticipates spending over \$50,000.00 annually on the through the purchasing of locksmith and security system services and supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby approves the City's use of the Jackson County, Missouri contract with Kenton Brothers Inc., Contract #14-17 (referred to as "Cooperative Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Procurement Division of the Finance Department and incorporated herein by reference, and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement by and between the City and Kenton Brothers Inc., attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, to purchase locksmith and security system services and supplies on an as-needed basis.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
