After general discussion, the Committee directed staff to make the following suggested changes on the Legislative Priorities brochure:

- (1) 1-470 changes (adding vehicle count)
- (2) Issues with 3rd Street and Hwy 50
- (3) Amtrak expansion
- (4) Increase funding for ROW maintenance and litter clean-up

Brian will make the Committee's changes to the Legislative Priorities that were discussed and send to Creative Services for final design.
