Primary scope	Regulates “Regulated Intoxicating Products” = intoxicating hemp-derived cannabinoids + intoxicating kratom-derived products.	Kratom-focused: bans “Prohibited Kratom Derivatives” and restricts other kratom products to 21+.	Regulates kratom products + prohibits sale/distribution of certain dangerous chemical inhalants (nitrous oxide, butyl nitrite, amyl nitrite) for recreational use contexts.

Product bans / potency limits	Defines intoxicating kratom-derived products to include 7-OH, Pseudoindoxyl, and concentrated mitragynine extracts; regulated via age/access controls (no numeric potency threshold stated).	Bans sale of “Prohibited Kratom Derivatives” (7-OH above natural concentrations; Pseudoindoxyl; synthetic isomers/derivatives) and bans possession of prohibited derivatives (all ages).	Prohibits sale/distribution of kratom products that are adulterated; have 7-hydroxymitragynine >2% of alkaloid fraction; are child-appealing confection/candy-like; are combustible/vapeable; or are sold without a Kratom Retail License.
Display / access controls	Products must be displayed so customers cannot possess before sale (e.g., behind counter or locked cabinet).	Not specified	Unlawful to display/store kratom products so they can be accessed by individuals under 21.
Licensing / business regulation	Not specified	Violations subject business license denial/suspension/revocation under City Code Ch.5.	Requires Kratom Retail License; directs City Manager to develop licensing program administered/enforced by Regulated Industries within 45 days; also provides for business license suspension/revocation procedures.
Penalties	Not specified	Ordinance violation punishable up to \$500 fine and/or up to 6 months incarceration; each separate sale/violation is separate offense.	Penalties: \$1–\$1,000 and/or up to 6 months incarceration; each day continuing is separate offense. Also public nuisance declaration and administrative license action.
Effective date	15 days after passage/approval	Effective after passage and approval pursuant to City Charter.	Takes effect 60 days after passage.
