B. [2026-7559](#) Presentation: E-Bike and E-Scooter Regulations

Captain Mike Murray, Police Department, provided an overview of e-bike definitions, the various classifications of bikes and different speeds of the bikes. He also reviewed current city ordinances pertaining to e-bikes regarding uses, operation/driving of, applicability of traffic laws and neighborhood vehicle guidelines.

He explained there were several different ordinances pertaining to e-bikes which made seeking information cumbersome and enforcement challenging as they were not consolidated. He highlighted the enforcement efforts currently in place when there is a violation and reviewed the education efforts to provide additional information to the public.

Tracy Albers, Director of Development Services, thanked Chair Hodges for her service and leadership on the City Council and on this committee.
