AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, THROUGH THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD AND JACKSON COUNTY MISSOURI FOR THE "TRIP THE LIGHT FANTASTIC: BICYCLE RIDE THROUGH CHRISTMAS IN THE PARK" EVENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit is a constitutional charter City, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri ("City"); and,

WHEREAS, the Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation Board ("Board") is empowered with the control of the supervision, improvement, care, and custody of parks and recreation activities in the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County Missouri, is a charter county and political subdivision and wishes to use parking at the Longview Community Center for the "Trip the Light Fantastic: Bicycle ride through Christmas in the Park" event on November 23, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the City and Board routinely cooperate with other political subdivisions to facilitate events for the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, Section 70.220, RSMo. and Section 4.4(d) of the Charter of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, requires that the Mayor execute all agreements and contracts between the City and other governmental entities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Lee's Summit, through the Parks and Recreation Board, and Jackson County Missouri, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute Exhibit A, the same or substantially similar, on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
