AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AND THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION RELATED TO THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT DESIGNATED AS FEDERAL PROJECT NUMBER TAP-3001(015), WARD ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FROM BLUE PARKWAY TO O'BRIEN ROAD, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the FY2023 Capital Improvement Plan and Thoroughfare Master Plan, the City planned for improvements along Ward Road between Blue Parkway and O'Brien Road to enhance safety and accommodate non-motorized transportation ("Project"); and,

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission ("MoDOT") approved the City's submittal of the Project for Transportation Alternatives Program federal funding in the amount not to exceed \$900,000 ("Federal Project Number TAP-3001(015)"); and,

WHEREAS, an agreement between the City and MoDOT is necessary to memorialize the mutual covenants, promises, and representations for Federal Project Number TAP-3001(015) for the Transportation Alternatives Program ("TAP Funding Agreement").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby approves the TAP Funding Agreement as attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.
- SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same or substantially similar on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.
- SECTION 3. The Mayor, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.
- SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
- SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
