AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PUBLIC SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT AND LSGOAL26, INC. FOR SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE CITY IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00.

WHEREAS, LSGOAL26, Inc. (hereinafter "LSGOAL") is a Missouri not-for-profit corporation with a designation from the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(4) entity, organized exclusively for the purpose of assisting in the preparations for and supporting the Lee's Summit community during the 2026 international soccer tournament being held in the United States, Mexico and Canada in June and July, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, LSGOAL has established a plan to carry out its mission, which includes efforts and initiatives related to community preparation and public engagement, as well as hosting community celebration events, all focusing on the welfare of the community; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the efforts of LSGOAL will provide a direct positive benefit to the City, its residents, and the economy, through the provision of activities for residents and visitors as well as through increased visibility to the community, and has further determined that it is in the best interests of the City and important to the promotion of the general economic welfare of the City to partner with LSGOAL for the provision of certain services as set forth in the attached public service agreement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The public service agreement between the City and LSGOAL26, INC. (LSGOAL) attached hereto as Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, is hereby approved for the not to exceed amount of \$50,000.00, and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement in substantial compliance with the attached version. The City Council hereby delegates authority to City staff to negotiate such changes to the Agreement and its exhibits as are necessary to complete the Agreement and carry out the purposes and intent of the Project for the City, provided that the price paid for the services and the other items which constitute the consideration do not change.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
