 24-085 An Ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances Section 2-339 Determination of Final Average Salary to change the time period used for determining a member employee's final average salary from a sixty (60) consecutive-month period to a thirty-six (36) consecutive-month period with the Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System.
