AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN ON APPROXIMATELY 1.61 ACRES LOCATED AT 1270 SE CENTURY DRIVE, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 33, THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Application #PL2025-052 submitted by Engineering Solutions, requesting approval of a preliminary development plan on land located at 1270 SE Century Dr was referred to the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Ordinance provides for the approval of a preliminary development plan by the City following public hearings by the Planning Commission and City Council; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the Planning Commission held a public hearing for the consideration of the preliminary development plan on July 10, 2025, and rendered a report to the City Council recommending that the preliminary development plan be approved; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the City Council held a public hearing on August 5, 2025, and rendered a decision to approve the preliminary development plan for said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That a preliminary development plan is hereby approved on the following described property:

Lot 17C, EASTSIDE BUSINESS PARK, a subdivision in Lee's Summit, Jackson County, Missouri.

SECTION 2. That the following conditions of approval apply:

- 1. A modification shall be granted to the maximum allowable 40% use of metal on any façade, to allow the following percentages of metal on the respective facades: 57% on the north elevation; 88% on the east elevation; 76% on the south elevation; and 100% on the west elevation.
- 2. The development shall occur in accordance with the Preliminary Development Plan dated June 13, 2025.

SECTION 3. Nonseverability. All provisions of this ordinance are so essentially and inseparably connected with, and so dependent upon, each other that no such provision would be enacted without all others. If a court of competent jurisdiction enters a final judgment on the merits that is not subject to appeal and that declares any provision or part of this ordinance void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then this ordinance, in its collective entirety, is invalid and shall have no legal effect as of the date of such judgment.
