5. Discussion:

City Council - Regular Session Action Letter December 2, 2025

A. 2025-7350 Continued Discussion: Contracted Residential Solid Waste Services

Mayor Baird noted this initiative received a lot of community feedback with many citizens expressing concerns going to a City-wide trash hauler. Because of this, council agreed that the citizens should be able to vote on the matter. As of now, the RFP process will go forward so pricing/costs can be determined and citizens have all the information for when they vote.

Michael Park, Director of Public Works, stated they should have the bid process complete by the end of January 2026 and will have those costs available.

Ballot options were discussed with November 2026 being the most favored.

Brian Head, City Attorney, will work with council for any legalities that may arise. The main date to note is the ballot certification for November 2026 is end of August 2026.

A Resolution will likely be drafted expressing the intent of the Council with an Ordinance to follow for an official determination of a ballot vote.

David Bushek, Chief Counsel of Economic Development and Planning, presented. Mr. Bushek gave a brief history of the Longview TIF's and noted the initial intent of the council that voted on this was to continue to provide funding for the preservation of the historic buildings of the area. Due to state statute, the TIF's must be activated at 10 years or the incentives are no longer available. He also noted that there is currently no planned development for these particular TIF's.

He also noted we will be hosting the upcoming Missouri Municipal League Meeting at Green Street in January.
