**BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENTS ACTION:** On a motion by Mr. Sauter and seconded by Mr. Campbell, the BZA voted unanimously (4-0) by voice vote to **APPROVE** the following: 1) a variance to the minimum 25' rear yard setback for an uncovered deck in the R-1 zoning district, to allow an 18'-6" setback from the rear property line; and 2) a variance to the minimum 30' rear yard setback for a covered deck in the R-1 zoning district, to allow a 20' setback from the rear property line.
