AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INCREASE IN THE AUTHORIZED CONTRACT AMOUNT FROM \$124,000.000 TO \$174,000 FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH BELLESAGE PARTNERS TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL PAYROLL SUPPORT AND WORKDAY PAYROLL SYSTEM FIXES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri (the "City") engaged Bellesage Partners to assist with the implementation of Fire Payroll methodology changes; and

WHEREAS, Bellesage Partners has demonstrated expertise in Workday and has become a trusted partner, possessing familiarity with the City of Lee's Summit Workday configuration and existing payroll issues; and

WHEREAS, the City's Payroll Supervisor resigned and the position is currently frozen, creating a need for temporary payroll support of which Bellesage Partners can provide; and

WHEREAS, the City is reaching the limit of the current authorized spending of amount to \$124,000.000 and needs to increase the spending limit by \$50,000 for a total of \$174,000 for the services of Bellesage Partners:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an additional sum of \$50,000 for the services of Bellesage Partners to provide payroll support and fixes under Ordinance 10364 for a total not to exceed price of \$174,000. The Scope of Work which is attached to that ordinance, remains in full force and effect. The City Manager is authorized to execute such amendments to the Agreement as are in substantial compliance with the original ordinance. The City Council hereby delegates authority to City staff to negotiate such changes to the Agreement and its exhibits as are necessary to complete the Agreement and carry out the purposes and intent of the Project for the City, provided that the price paid for the services and the other items which constitute the consideration do not substantially change.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
