Ballot Language - Public Safety

Shall the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$18,500,000.00 for the purpose of making public safety improvements including (a) the acquisition, construction, furnishing and equipping of a new fire station and the purchase of associated apparatus to replace Fire Station No. 4, (b) the acquisition, construction, furnishing and equipping of a new fire station to replace Fire Station No. 5, (c) the acquisition and installation of new police automobile video systems and police body-worn camera systems, and (d) renovations and improvements to enhance facility security, public access, customer service and operational efficiency in the Police and Courts Municipal Building?



Ballot Language - Network Infrastructure

Shall the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$975,000 for the purpose of purchasing and installing new infrastructure to renovate, improve and upgrade the City's wireless and fiber optic communication network systems for City facilities?



<u>Ballot Language – Curb Replacement</u>

Shall the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$450,000 for the purpose of replacing and improving street curbs within City rights-of-way?



Station 4 Coverage Area





- Response time challenges (4 minute travel time for first responding unit)





- \$1 MM
- 1-year project



- Complete replacement of audio/visual patrol vehicle recording system
- Body-worn cameras and data storage solution
- Current in-car provider no longer supporting data server
- System integration

Constructed in 1997



Police / Courts Facility Renovations

- \$5.5 MM
- 2 3 year project
- Security needs / increase operational efficiency / customer service & public access
- Space needs study in progress
- Expand locker room facilities for women



Network Infrastructure

- \$975,000
- 1-2 year project
- Replace aerial fiber with new buried fiber
 - Douglas Street (Fire HQ to Police HQ)
- Install New Fiber network connectivity
 - Water Service Center
 - Fire Station 2
 - Harris Park Community Center
 - Longview Recreation Center



Curb Replacement

- \$450,000
- Ongoing work and funding will enhance annual curb replacement program
 - Annual program replaces approximately \$1 MM per year
