

**Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic
Security Act (“CARES Act”):
JACO Appropriations for Lee’s Summit**

CARES Act

- ✓ **Established the Coronavirus Relief Fund**
- ✓ **Appropriated \$150 Billion**
- ✓ **Funds to be used to make payments for specified uses to States and certain local governments**

CARES Act Funds

➤ **May only be used to cover costs that:**

- 01 are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)**
- 02 were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government; and**
- 03 were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020**

Prior Expenses, Requests, Budget Recommendation

Public Health [2]	\$ 3,412,018
Payroll Expenses [3]	\$ 656,000
Compliance with Public Health Measures [4]	\$ 279,220
Economic Support [5]	\$ 560,000
Other Related Expenses [6]	\$ 771,200
Total Budget	\$ 5,921,527

*Includes expenses incurred through 05.31.2020

- ✓ **Approval of an ordinance approving the proposed budget plan authorizing the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement between the City and Jackson County in accordance with the proposed funding plan of \$5,921,527. (See proposed funding plan document in packet.)**
