- 1. The District hereby nominates Jim Hand to serve a new four-year term as a Property Owner Representative (new term is 5/26/2024-5/25/2028).
- 2. The District hereby nominates Rick Taylor to serve a new four-year term as a Property Owner Representative (new term is 5/26/2024-5/25/2028).
- 3. The District hereby nominates Mark Dunning to serve a new four-year term as a Property Owner Representative (new term is 5/26/2024-5/25/2028).
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
