Discussion: Updating Disorderly Conduct Ordinance

Staff reviewed the City's current ordinances to assess the tools police officers have to address certain disruptive/anti social behaviors.

There are three behaviors commonly pertaining to disruptive conduct:

- 1. acting in a disorderly manner, also called a breach of the peace
- 2. being drunk in public
- 3. prowling

Combined with the new ordinances presented at this meeting concerning Panhandling and Loitering, staff believes current ordinances sufficiently cover this subject matter.

6. Roundtable

Councilmember Prier stated she has received complaints about people renting their pools for parties and asked if the City had any ordinances addressing that topic.

Tracy Albers, Director of Development Services, said it is not explicitly stated in the City's short term rental provision, but pools and pool houses are categorized as accessory structures in our code and short term rentals are not allowed to take place in accessory structures.

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Ryan Elam, Assistant City Manager, stated staff will continue to present more ordinances relating to the World Cup and review the City's regulations matrix at the next CEDC meeting. He also reminded everyone that Green Street will open this weekend.

7. Adjournment

Hearing no further business, Chair Hodges adjourned the August 13, 2025 Community and Economic Development Committee meeting at 5:41 p.m.
