PROJECT NAME: QUIK TRIP - 801 SE M-291 HWY PROJECT TYPE: Prel Dev Plan (PDP)

SURROUNDING ENVIRONMENT (Streets, Developments)

The proposed development is located at the northeast corner of the MO 291 Hwy and US 50 Hwy interchange. The existing QT location sits just north of Blue Parkway. Blue Parkway will be relocated to the north and the proposed QT will be located between the US 50 WB off ramp and Blue Parkway.

ALLOWABLE ACCESS

The proposed development will be accessed from two access points on the north to Blue Parkway. The first access is a Right In Right Out access approximately 180 FT from the intersection. The second access point is approximately 580 FT east of the intersection and is a full access.

EXISTING STREET CHARACTERISTICS (Lanes, Speed limits, Sight Distance, Medians)

The Quik Trip store is being relocated as a result of the MO 291/US 50 Highway interchange project. With the project, Blue Parkway will move further north of the interchange and will be a two-way undivided roadway with a short median at the intersection of MO 291. The road will have a speed limit of 35 MPH. MO 291 is generally a four-lane divided highway with a median beginning at Oldham Road to the south and approximately 400 FT to the north of the Blue Parkway intersection. The US 50 Hwy ramp to the south will be 4 lanes.

The access points along Blue Parkway do not meet City Access Mangement requirements. However, these access points were approved with the MoDOT design of the interchange and with their approval a variance is acceptable.
