AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TRAINING AND DUTY AMMUNITION THROUGH THE COOPERATIVE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSOURI AND SUNSET LAW ENFORCEMENT LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$132,532.15 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit Missouri (the "City") and the Lee's Summit Police Department has a need to purchase both training and duty ammunition in support of its officers for the fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the City's Procurement Policy allows the City to make purchases from contracts that were originally procured by another entity, who has extended the pricing and terms of such contract to other entities such as the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City can utilize a contract for the purchase of ammunition pursuant to a contract between the State of Missouri and Sunset Law Enforcement LLC; and,

WHEREAS, the City anticipates spending over \$75,00.00 annually on the purchase of training and duty ammunition.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby approves the City's use of the State of Missouri contract for training and duty ammunition with Sunset Law Enforcement LLC (referred to as "Cooperative Agreement," contract #CC240449008), attached as Exhibit "A" and authorizes the City Manager to purchase training and duty ammunition through this Cooperative Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$132,532.15 as reflected in the Quote attached hereto as Exhibit "B" authorizing the city manager to execute any documents necessary to effectuate this purchase

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
