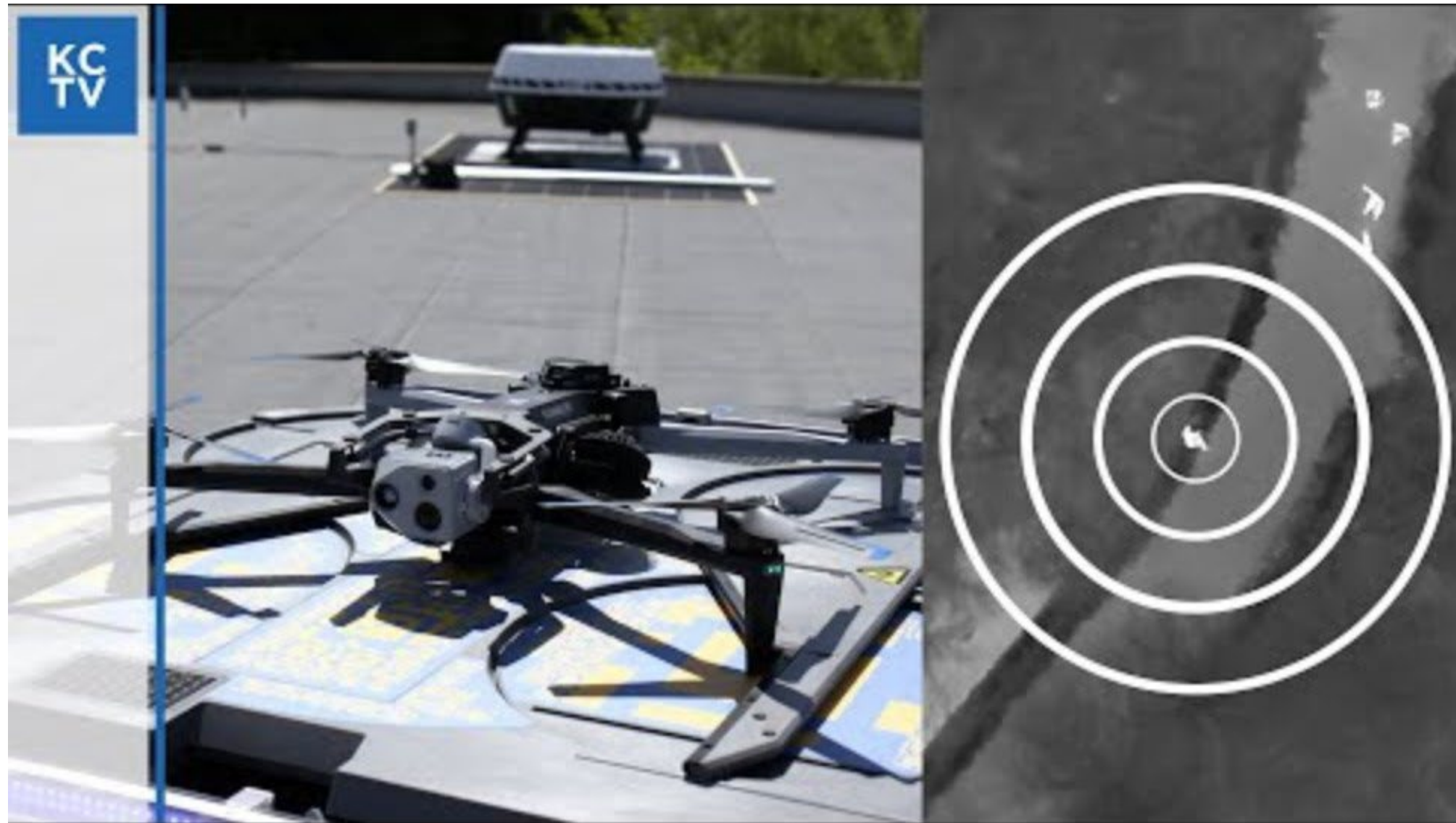
Part of NTI Bond, construction estimated to be completed mid-September 2026

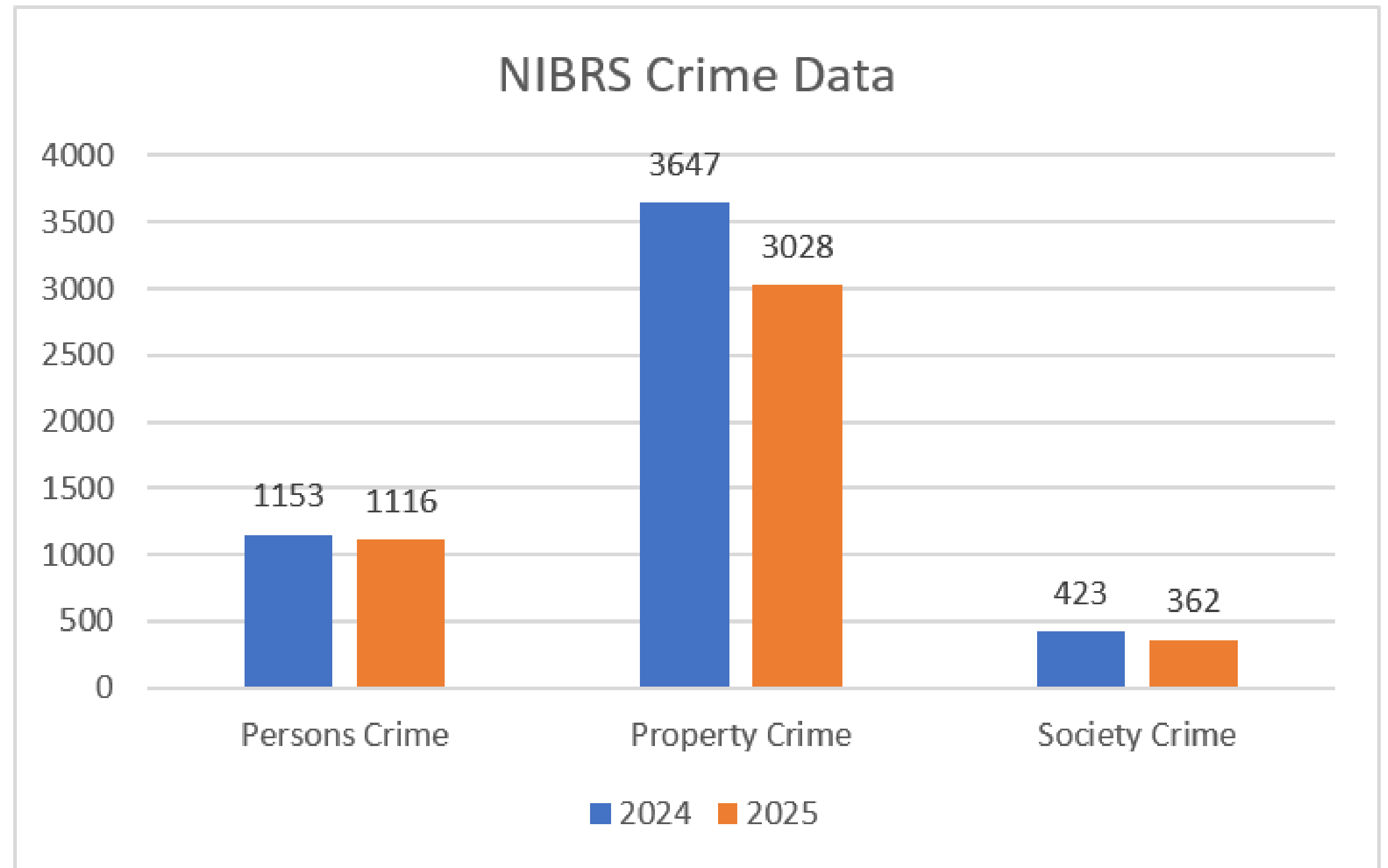


Drones as First Responders (DFR)



- Dearborn PD (similar size to Lee's Summit) is deploying DFR for nearly instant response
- Dearborn and Lee's Summit are about the same in size
- Working towards a negative response time, faster than traditional policing

Lee's Summit Crime Data for 2025



	Bridging Program	COPS Hiring Program
Total Funding	\$3 Billion	~\$150–160 Million
Who Can Be Hired	Sworn officers and civilian positions (e.g., analysts, investigators)	Sworn officers only
Personnel Funding	Up to 3 years of salary + benefits (can be up to 100% federal share)	Up to 3 years , up to 75% federal share (max ~\$125k per officer)
Post-grant Requirements	Sustainability plan	12-month obligation

Note: Bridging program requires coordination with immigration enforcement.
