AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR TRANSIT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AND THE KANSAS CITY AREA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (KCATA), FOR A PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022, WITH A ONE-YEAR OPTION TO RENEW, AND COMMITMENT OF FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5307 FORMULA FUNDS AND CARES ACT FUNDS TO KCATA FOR ELIGIBLE OPERATING AND CAPITAL EXPENSES, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority ("KCATA") is a public agency authorized by law to plan, own, operate, have, and generally deal with public transportation systems and facilities in the KCATA district and,

WHEREAS, since 1999, the City of Lee's Summit ("City") has contracted with KCATA for a commuter bus service, Lee's Summit Express, for service between Lee's Summit and downtown Kansas City; and,

WHEREAS, the City regularly reviews and renews transit contracts with KCATA to provide the appropriate level of service based on user demand while keeping costs for services within the City's budget; and,

WHEREAS, for 2022, KCATA recommends to resume ridership to pre-COVID levels of 6 trips per day; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with KCATA for a period from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022, with a one-year option to renew, for said transit services, to coincide with the OATS service agreement period ("Transit Service Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, funding for the Transit Service Agreement is sourced by the local Transportation Sales Tax budgeted in the FY2022 and FY2023 Capital Improvement Plan and federal FTA Section 5307 formula funds and CARES Act funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby approves the Transit Services Agreement, substantially similar to the attached Exhibit 1, incorporated herein by reference, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
