AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF RFP NO. 2022-038, FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE TRAINING SERVICES ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS, TO DIVERSIFIED LOGISTICS TRAINING SOLUTIONS (DLTS), FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM WITH UP TO FOUR, ONE-YEAR RENEWALS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, multiple departments require employees to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) as a job requirement to operate equipment with GVWR over 26,001 pounds; and,

WHEREAS, beginning February 7, 2022, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration is imposing additional requirements for entry-level drivers; and,

WHEREAS, theory and behind the wheel curricula must cover all topics outlined in 49 CFR, Part 380, appendices A through E; and,

WHEREAS, entry-level drivers must obtain applicable training from a provider listed on the Training Provider Registry, prior to taking a relevant behind the wheel skills or knowledge test; and,

WHEREAS, instructors must meet the requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, subtitle B, Chapter III, Subchapter B, Part 308.605.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby approves the award of RFP No. 2022-038, for the purchase of commercial driver's license training services on an as needed basis, to Diversified Logistics Training Solutions (DLTS), for a one-year term with up to four, one-year renewals, substantially similar to said agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit 1".

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
