Councilmember Felker asked for an update on the PRI properties and discussions with them.

Mr. Steve Arbo, City Manager, stated the City is currently working with PRI with several different agreements including infrastructure, but it is not information that can be provided publicly at this time.

14. Staff Roundtable

Mr. Mark Dunning, Assistant City Manager, noted the Chipman Road Closure was delayed by MoDOT due to weather. They will begin closing ramps on March 24th to prepare them for the highway traffic. The Chipman Road will be closed on April 11th and will not open until the beginning of 2023.
