## **BILL NO. 22-67**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND JACKSON COUNTY ELECTRICAL SERVICES, INC., TO PURCHASE ELECTRICAL SERVICES AND SUPPLIES AS NEEDED AND RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S EXECUTION OF THE SAME FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, after a competitive procurement process, the City of Independence, Missouri and Jackson County Electrical Services, Inc. executed a contract dated March 3, 3022 ("Independence Contract"), to provide the City of Independence with electrical services and supplies; and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the City of Lee's Summit's ("City") Procurement Policy allows the City to use contracts competitively bid by other governmental entities to ensure an efficient and effective use of resources; and,

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2022 the City executed a contract with Jackson County Electrical Services, Inc. ("Contract No. 2022-049") to permit the City to use the Independence Contract to purchase electrical services and supplies on an as needed basis; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4 of the City's Procurement Policy, the City Manager executed Contract No. 2022-049 because the estimated annual spend was less than \$50,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the City would like to use Contract No. 2022-049 for various small, on-call projects, but anticipates that the annual cost of such projects will exceed \$50,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Procurement Policy requires City Council approval if an existing City contract has or is anticipated to have an annual spend of \$50,000.00 or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby approves Contract 2022-049 between the City and Jackson County Electrical Services, Inc., attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, to purchase electrical supplies and services, and ratifies the City Manager's previous execution of Contract No. 2022-049.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
