## **BILL NO. 22-99**

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR PROJECT NO. 568-323-78 FOR THE BROWNING STREET EXTENSION – BROWNING ST. TO HAMBLEM RD. PROJECT TO AMINO BROS. CO., INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,397,845.08, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, as directed by the FY22 Capital Improvement Plan and Thoroughfare Master Plan, with recommendation by the License Tax Committee, the City called for the design of extended the roadway of Browning Street to Hamblen Road, thereby providing an alternate route in lieu of Oldham Parkway and improving the access management for existing and future industrial and commercial development (hereinafter "Project No. 568-323-78"); and,

WHEREAS, the total project budget for Project No. 568-323-78 is funded primarily from the License (Excise) Tax but also from the Sewer Construction and Water Construction Funds; and,

WHEREAS, Public Works Engineering issued an advertisement for bids for the construction of Project No. 568-323-78 on March 14, 2022, guided by local policies and state statutes; and,

WHEREAS, Amino Bros. Co., Inc. ("Contractor") was determined to be the lowest and best bidder by City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor to construct Project No. 568-323-78.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the bid for Project No. 568-323-78 to the Contractor in the amount of \$3,397,845.08.

SECTION 2. The agreement between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Contractor, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved and the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement substantially similar to the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take such further action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
