AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR GERBER COLLISION ON LAND LOCATED AT 575 NW BLUE PKWY, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 33, THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Application #PL2022-066 submitted by Burman Companies, requesting approval of a preliminary development plan on land located at 575 NW Blue Pkwy was referred to the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Ordinance provides for the approval of a preliminary development plan by the City following public hearings by the Planning Commission and City Council; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the Planning Commission held public hearings for the consideration of the preliminary development plan on April 28, 2022, and rendered a report to the City Council recommending that the preliminary development plan be approved; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the City Council held a public hearing on May 24, 2022, and rendered a decision to approve the preliminary development plan for said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That a preliminary development plan is hereby approved on the following described property:

Lot 3B, Replat of Lot 3, McCord Addition.

SECTION 2. That the following conditions of approval apply:

- A modification shall be granted to the required minimum six (6) foot parking lot setback from an internal lot line to allow for a three (3) foot setback from the existing parking lot and a four (4) foot setback from the proposed drive lane as depicted on sheet C103 of the preliminary development plan dated March 21, 2022.
- 2. Development shall be in accordance with the preliminary development plan dated March 21, 2022 and shall include a 6' vinyl fence as depicted on the site plan dated March 21, 2022, revised May 13, 2022.

SECTION 3. Nonseverability. All provisions of this ordinance are so essentially and inseparably connected with, and so dependent upon, each other that no such provision would be enacted without all others. If a court of competent jurisdiction enters a final judgment on the merits that is not subject to appeal and that declares any provision or part of this ordinance void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then this ordinance, in its collective entirety, is invalid and shall have no legal effect as of the date of such judgment.

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SECTION 4. That failure to comply with all of the provisions contained in this ordinance shall constitute violations of both this ordinance and Chapter 33, the City's Unified Development Ordinance, of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Lee's Summit.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
