## **BILL NO. 22-145**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE CONTRACT BETWEEN PUBLIC SAFETY ASSOCIATION, INC. AND STRYKER SALES, LLC, TO PURCHASE AND MAINTAIN EMERGENCY MEDICAL EQUIPMENT, AND RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S EXECUTION OF THE SAME TO ALLOW FOR EXPANDED SPENDING AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the Lee's Summit Fire Department uses specific emergency medical equipment manufactured replaced and maintained at prescribed intervals; and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the Procurement policy allows the City to make purchases from contracts that were originally procured by another entity but have extended the pricing and terms of such contract to other entities such as the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City currently purchases the needed medical equipment pursuant to a contract between the Public Safety Association, Inc. and Stryker Sales, LLC ("Contract No. 2022-035"); and,

WHEREAS, the City would like to use Contract No. 2022-035 to make additional purchases, but such purchase will cause the annual spend under the contract to exceed \$50,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Procurement Policy requires City Council approval if an existing City contract has or is anticipated to have an annual spend of \$50,000.00 or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the City's use of the contract between Public Safety Association, Inc. and Stryker Sales, LLC ("Cooperative Contract"), attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, to purchase, repair and maintain emergency medical equipment, and ratifies the City Manager's previous execution all documents necessary to use the Cooperative Contract for the purpose of allowing annual expenditures of \$50,000 or more under such contract.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
