

LSPR Funding (FY22)



<u>A Vibrant Community with a</u> <u>Great Parks System</u>

- 88% community satisfaction in programs, facilities, and parks from 2019 ETC survey (2nd highest rated city department)
- 80% voter approval to renew ¼ cent Park Sales Tax in August, 2016
- 2010 Gold Medal for Best Park Agency in the nation
- CAPRA Accreditation in 2003, 2008, 2013, and 2018







Planning For Future Success

- LSPR Parks Master Plan 2017
- LSPR Parks Master Plan Update 2022
- Greenway and Trails Master Plan 2019
- Community Input and engagement in neighborhood park improvements, facilities, and trails
- Leveraging Resources
 - Community Partnerships
 - Federal, State, Local Grants

Established Goals for "Legacy for Tomorrow and Beyond"

- A Park within ½ mile of all residents
- 10 acres of neighborhood park per 1,000 residents
- 10 acres of community park per 1,000 residents

In 2022 LSPR currently has

- Approximately <u>30,000 dwelling units within a</u> <u>10 min walk</u> (1/2 mile) of a local or regional park (72%)
- Approximately **1,250** acres of regional, community, and neighborhood parks
- Current "Level of Service" is <u>12.5 acres of</u> <u>park/1,000 residents</u>

<u>Responding to Future</u> <u>Growth...</u>

By 2040 (from 2021 IGNITE Comprehensive Plan)

- Lee's Summit is projected to have a population of 140,000 with approximately 59,000 dwelling units
- In order to maintain the current level of parks per capita, Lee's Summit will need a total of 1,725 park acres, an increase of approximately 500 acres
- Need to consider future mechanisms for parks to meet anticipated growth. Park Board has considered
 - Land Dedication Ordinance
 - Park Impact Fees
