WHEREAS, 65% of all fatalities in 2021 Missouri traffic crashes were unbuckled; and,

**WHEREAS**, traffic crashes are the leading cause of death for people between the age of 15 and 20, with distracted driving being one of the primary causes; and,

**WHEREAS**, by buckling up and putting your phone down, you will do your part to help make Missouri's roads safer and save lives; and,

**WHEREAS**, as the Mayor of the Lee's Summit, I encourage Lee's Summit residents to join the more than 20,000 people and 700 businesses that have pledged to make the roads safer for themselves and others by taking the Buckle Up Phone Down Challenge.
